

CODE OF CONDUCT

STUDENTS WILL:

- attend regularly and be prepared for learning
- make learning a first priority
- being committed to performing high standards
- behave in a safe and peaceful manner at all times
- conduct yourself during all activities in such a way that the rights of all are respected
- follow directions to the best of your ability, the first time they are given
- communicate with parents and staff through the use of the planner
- treat all public and private property with respect
- comply with dress code
- report teasing or bullying

Specific yard expectations:

- engage in peaceful activities with no rough play
- comply immediately with yard supervisors' instructions
- stay on the school property within the fenced boundaries unless written permission is given by parent/guardian
- line up immediately and quietly in single file by class when the bell goes, enter the school in an orderly and safe manner
- leave snow, sticks and stones on the ground
- enter the school building before the bell only with the permission of the staff member
- refrain from inappropriate language, gestures, verbal teasing, bullying and littering
- discuss problems with the supervisor immediately
